

## **Slavery & Human Trafficking Statement**

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and sets out the steps we have taken to ensure that our business as well as our supply chains are free from slavery and human trafficking during the financial year ending 31/03/2018.

Metal Agencies Ltd is committed to preventing slavery and human trafficking occurring in any of its corporate activities, as well as seeking to ensure that our supply chains are also free from such practices.

Metal Agencies Ltd, situated in Byfleet, Surrey is the wholly owned UK subsidiary company of the Viohalco Group, involved in the importation, sales and distribution of the products manufactured within the Group. We remain our own legal entity within the UK for reporting purposes and employ 16 people.

Our Anti-Slavery Policy reflects our commitment to implementing and enforcing effective procedures and controls to minimise the risks of human trafficking and other modern slavery practices infiltrating our business operations or supply chains, and to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business activities and relationships.

Our policies have been developed in consultation with our employees and we ensure that our suppliers are aware of our policies.
